1. Schedule A of your report discloses contributions with aggregate year-to-date totals which appear to reflect refunds of contribution(s) made in a prior year. Please be advised that the aggregate year-to-date total for a contributor should reflect only those contributions received within that calendar year. Please amend your report to provide the correct aggregate year-to-date totals.
2. Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Contributions to the federal account of a state party committee should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule B, supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing. (2 U.S.C § 434(b) and FORM 3X Instructions)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will**
