Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) (see attached) of your 2009 August Monthly Report (7/1/09-7/31/09) discloses \$16,661.28 in disbursements to "American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons Political Action Committee" for "2nd qtr staff support." Additionally, Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) (see attached) of your 2009 November Monthly Report (10/1/09-10/31/09) discloses \$19,447.31 in disbursements to "American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons Political Action Committee" for "3rd qtr staff support, UPS refund of bank fee." You are 11 CFR §102.5 prohibits a non-federal account from advised that financing activity in connection with federal elections. Please provide clarifying information regarding these transactions including the date(s) when the original activity was conducted by the non-federal account. In addition, if any of these disbursements were made to influence the election or defeat of specific federal candidates, the disbursements should be allocated accordingly and disclosed as either in-kind contributions on Schedule B supporting Line 23, or as independent expenditures on Schedule E supporting Line 24. 11 CFR §§104.3(b)(3) and 106.1

Although the Commission may initiate legal action regarding the activities conducted by your non-federal account, any clarifying information that you can provide will be taken into consideration.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
