This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-On Schedule H3 supporting Line 18 of the Detailed Summary Page, you have not provided the unique identifying codes of the Direct Fundraising events for which transfers were received. Please amend your report to include this missing information. 11 CFR §104.10

-On Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page, you have failed to include a unique identifying title or code for the payments made to the U.S. Postal Service, Cable & Wireless, Inc., Alchar Printing, Lortech Corporation, Welch, Campbell & Pusateri, First Impressions, MCI, NYNEX and the Mailworks. 11 CFR §104.10. Please amend this report (including all affected schedules) to provide a unique identifying title or code for each PURPOSE/EVENT.

-Schedule H4 discloses a disbursement(s) for the Annual Dinner and Empire Lunch Rochester fundraising event(s) which appears to be using a ratio(s) inconsistent with those disclosed on Schedule H2. Please amend your report to clarify this apparent discrepancy.


