To ensure compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act), please respond to this request (copy enclosed).


Due to recent events, the United States Postal Service is experiencing delays in the processing and delivery of mail for the Washington D.C. area. Consequently, the Federal Election Commission is not in receipt of all incoming mail. The Commission recommends that you resubmit your response to this notice and consider using alternate delivery services such as overnight delivery or delivery by courier. If feasible, your response can also be hand-delivered. You can verify the Commission's receipt of any documents submitted by your committee on the FEC website at [www.FEC.gov](http://www.FEC.gov).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by August 6, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and

reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

- Schedule B discloses an in-kind contribution to Paul Wellstone for the 2002 General Election made after 10/25/2002; however, once a candidate is no longer a candidate in the general election, all contributions made should be returned. 11 CFR §110.1(b)(3)

If any apparently impermissible contribution in question was incompletely or incorrectly disclosed, you should amend your original report to with clarifying information.

Please inform the Commission of your corrective action immediately in writing and provide a photocopy of the refund request sent to the recipient committee. In addition, any refunds received should be reported on Line 16 of the Detailed Summary Page and on Schedule A. 11 CFR §110.1(b)


Although the Commission may take further legal action regarding this impermissible activity, your prompt action in obtaining a refund will be taken into consideration.

-Line 21(a) of the Detailed Summary Page discloses joint federal/non-federal operating expenditures during the reporting period. Committees must itemize each allocated disbursement made from its

federal account or separate allocation account regardless of the amount.  
Please amend your report(s) by itemizing the expenditures on Schedule H4.  
11 CFR §104.10

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter.
