Re: RFAI Year End 2005

Dear Mr. Decker:

This Miscellaneous Report responds to the Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") dated February 22, 2006, referencing the International Brotherhood of Boilermakers, Iron Shipbuilders, Blacksmiths, Forgers & Helpers - Legislative Education Fund ("Boilermakers PAC") 2005 Year End report.

The RFAI was issued in response to a reported transfer from "Boilermakers Local 13 Affiliated SSF," on December 29, 2005.

As our counsel explained to you in a telephone conversation on March 23, 2006, this should not have been reported as a transfer from an affiliated PAC. Local 13 is, in fact, a collecting agent for the Boilermakers PAC, and Local 13 has complied with the rules for collecting agents set forth at 11 C.F.R. 102.6. The funds transferred were comprised solely of individual voluntary contributions solicited and collected in accordance with FEC rules, and the transfer should have been reported as unitemized contributions from individuals.

This reporting error was completely unintentional and the Boilermakers PAC will immediately amend all necessary reports (and its statement of organization, which erroneously listed the Local 13 fund as a separate committee), to properly reflect the status of the funds as individual contributions to the Boilermakers PAC.
