Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Your amended report discloses an increase in receipts totaling \$45,200 from the amounts disclosed on your original report. Please amend your report or provide clarifying information as to why this activity was not disclosed on your original report. (11 CFR §104.3)

The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, "Due to an inadvertent administrative error, thirteen contributions that were received in this reporting period were not included in the original report. This error was discovered during the routine preparation of the third quarter report and is corrected here. Committee practices have been adjusted to prevent this from occurring in the future. In addition, because of a software feature related to how several split transactions were entered, the original report also contained nine contributions that appear as memo entries that did not tabulate to the summary pages of the report. These contributions were included in the original report and this amendment removes the memo entry designation inserted by the software system, resulting in an accurate tabulation of those contributions."

Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
