Re.: Amended April Monthly Report (3/1/08-3/31/08), your letter 7/11/08

Dear Ms. Seay:

In response to your letter we would like to state the following:

1. The transfer in of \$ 18036.36 from the nonfederal account for allocated activities was for the time period of November 8 to December 31, 2007; the total disbursements were \$ 28181.81. The transfer in of \$ 39524.99 on 3/3/08 from the nonfederal account for allocated activities was for the time period of January 1 to February 29, 2008; the total disbursements were \$ 61757.79. The ratio of these allocations was 36% federal and 64% nonfederal funds according to Schedule H1. The transfer in on 2/13/08 of \$ 80500.30 was for the time period of December 13 to February 12, 2008; the total disbursements were \$ 99393.13. The transfer in on 3/3/08 of \$ 69096.94 from the nonfederal account for allocated activities was for the time period of February 13 to February 29, 2008; the total disbursements were \$ 85304.86; the ratio for these allocations was 19% federal and 81 % nonfederal funds and was arrived by applying the funds received method.
2. The payments on Schedule H4 Line 21 for federal payroll taxes, health insurance, insurance, ITEMIZE: health insurance, net pay and state payroll taxes were activities for employees who spent 25% or less of their time during the month referenced above on FEA or activities in connection with a Federal election.
3. The ratio on Schedule H1 of this report is correct. Due to a clerical error an incorrect ratio was used at the beginning of the election cycle. We have since amended all returns and refunded the overpaid amount to our nonfederal account (see our Amended November 2007 report, Schedule B, Line 21b, filed 3/20/08).
4. The disbursement for research/voter file should have been paid for with 100% federal funds. We have transferred \$ 1280 back into our nonfederal account and will show this activity in our August 2008 report.
5. We have amended the report to show all memo entries on schedule H4.
