The Beto O?Rourke for Congress campaign makes best efforts to obtain, maintain and report the name, address, occupation and employer of all contributors who contribute more than $\$ 200$ in an election cycle.
\#1. We specifically request this information from all contributors and on all solicitations and inform contributors that we are required by law to collect and report this information to the FEC.
\#2. We train all fundraising volunteers about this requirement and ask them to obtain this information when collecting a contribution. Volunteers are directed to use a specific campaign contribution form that requests the required information and to work with the contributor to ensure that the form is completed.
\#3. If we do not obtain this information at the time the contribution is made, we follow up with the contributor within 30 days of the receipt of the contribution to request the required information. These requests for information are documented and maintained in our records.

The Beto O?Rourke for Congress campaign complies with safe harbor guidelines for all contributions with a foreign address by:
\#1. Contacting the contributor within 30 days of receipt of the contribution to request evidence that the contributor is either a U.S. Citizen or a Permanent Resident. This contact and the evidence provided are documented and maintained in our records.
\#2. If it is determined that the contributor is eligible to contribute then we maintain the contribution. If it is determined that the contributor is ineligible to contribute then we return the contribution. If the contributor does not respond, we will return the contribution.
\#3. In addition, all of our solicitations indicate that a contributor must either be a U.S. Citizen or a Permanent Resident.
