

Dear Mr. Jones:

This form 99 is in response to your letter of December 21, 2007 were you raised concerns about four main issues. Sections 1 & 2 questioning three checks to have been received as corporation checks.

This has been reviewed and reimbursement checks have been sent back to 'Smith and Nephew Inc.', 'Bill Carney & Company', and 'Goldbelt Raven, LLC'. You should receive a copy of these three checks via the mail.

To address the concerns of Sections 3 & 4 in regards to expenditures.

In section 3 the expenditures made for 'Events' and 'Golf Outing' were for supplies such as name tags, paper, other supplies in preparation and presentation for the event. A few miscellaneous prizes were provided. The bulk of the expenses were for the Maryland National Golf Club and their fees were for greens fees and associated golf fees or for the food provided at the event. The only federal Candidate in attendance was Congressman Roscoe Bartlett MD-06. He did not golf and therefore no Schedule B or E was outlined listing him.

In Section 4 the expenditure for 'Printing' was an administrative expense for things like paper, stamps, Stationary, etc. As well as for required information if the information for contributions is not complete than we send out a letter requesting this information and as per FEC guidelines we do not solicit a contribution with the letter, federal law requirement are outlined, and a pre-addressed return envelope is included. These letters are printed in bulk to be sent out when ever needed.

Thank you for bringing these concerns to our attention. I hope this clears up any confusion with our account. If not please do not hesitate to contact us.
