1. Column B figures for the Summary and Detailed Summary Page information should reflect only the current election cycle-to-date figures (11/7/2018 through 11/3/2020). Please amend your report to correct this error. (52 U.S.C. § 30104(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)) and 11 CFR § 104.3)

- For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, all contributions and transfers to political committees should be reported on Line 21 of the Detailed Summary Page and itemized on a separate Schedule B. (11 CFR \S 104.3(b)(2))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. For additional information about the
