Dear Mr. Walker,

UWe are in receipt of your December 4, 2002 Request for Additional Information for the July 2002 Quarterly Report.

UWe have taken the following actions in response to the your request:

1.UAmended the April 2002 Quarterly, July 2002 Quarterly, October 2002 Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General 2002, and 30 Day Post-General reports to reconcile all previously incorrect Lines 7, 23, 30 and 31. These reports now correctly reflect the period and year-to-date totals for the specified lines.

2.UAmended the April 2002 Quarterly, July 2002 Quarterly, October 2002 Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General 2002, and 30 Day Post-General reports Line 11's with the following description field for HSBC receipts: "individuals' contributions under \$200". This description should be adequate to clarify that none of the individual contributions exceed the \$200 itemization threshold. If this is not adequate for that purpose, please let us know.

3.UAmended the July 2002 Quarterly to reflect that the 6/27/02 contribution to the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee ("DCCC") was to the DCCC's non-federal account. Specifically, the contribution was moved to Line 29 and noted as "non-federal contribution."

4.UAmended the July 2002 Quarterly report to remove incorrectly reported (and, thus, apparently excessive) contributions to the Committee to Re-Elect Gene Green, the Jefferson Committee, and Luther for Congress. Included in the July 2002 Quarterly report were contributions that had been made in 2001, which caused the contributions to appear excessive. We do not know why those 2001 contributions were re-reported, but they have now been deleted.

5.UAmended the July 2002 Quarterly, October 2002 Quarterly, 12 Day Pre-General 2002, and 30 Day Post-General reports to include "office sought" for any federal candidate contribution missing that information.

6.U Amended the July 2002 Quarterly report to reflect that the contributions specified in the RFAI that were incorrectly reported as being made for the primary were, in fact, made for the general election.

UWe trust that these amendments, and our commitment to continue to report in the manner discussed above, should eliminate these problems from occurring in the future.
