This letter is in response to your letter dated June 12th and received at my office on June 17th concerning CULAC's March monthly report (2/1/02 - 2/28/02).

CULAC and its affiliated federal PACs inadvertently made contributions in excess of \$5,000 to Congressman Ed Royce of California and Senator Jeff Sessions of Alabama. We have requested that the campaigns refund the amount in excess of \$5,000 as soon as possible.
