This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:


-Line 10 of the Summary Page of your amended report, dated 1/31/02 discloses a total of \$4,350,000 in Debts and Obligations Owed by the Committee. The sum of the entry itemized on Schedule C, however, indicates the total to be \$3,016,500. Please note that a memo entry is not to be included in the total figure for a schedule. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

-Your report discloses receipts totaling \$64,746.18 from New York Senate 2000, Florida Senate 2000, Pennsylvania Fund, California Victory 2000 and Michigan 2000, which is a joint fundraising committee(s) affiliated with your committee. Please be advised that a memo Schedule A must be provided to itemize your committee's share of the gross contributions received through the joint fundraiser(s). The memo schedule should itemize each individual who has contributed an aggregate in excess of \$200 during the calendar year, and provide the amount of unitemized contributions received. In addition, the memo schedule should itemize your committee's share of all contributions from political committees, regardless

- of amount. Please amend your report by providing the omitted memo schedule(s). 11 CFR §102.17(c)(8)(i)(B)

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
