This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following $\underline{2}$ item(s):

1. Schedule B supporting Line 29 of the Detailed Summary Page discloses \$42,500 in activity identified as MEMO entries that do not appear to correspond with any itemized transaction(s). Please be advised, a memo entry is used to disclose additional information about an itemized transaction and the amount of a memo entry is not included in the total receipts or disbursements for the report. Please amend your report to provide clarifying information regarding this activity. (11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a) and (b))

2. Commission Regulations require the continuous reporting of all outstanding debts. This report omits debts itemized on your previous report(s). Please file an amendment to your report to disclose the current status of these omitted debts: "Elias Law Group" and "Nesbitt & Parrinello,Inc." (11 CFR §§ 104.3(d) and 104.11)

- Your report discloses in kind contributions made to a federal political action committee. The original payments for the goods and services have been itemized as operating expenditures and included in the total for Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page. In addition, the attribution to each federal candidate has been noted as a memo entry on supporting Schedule B for Line 23 (Contributions to Federal Candidates and Other Political Committees).

For your information and consideration when preparing future filings, please be advised that the amount of such activity should be disclosed on Line 23 of the

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Detailed Summary Page so that the total amount of contributions to federal candidates (including in-kind contributions) are properly included on Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page. (11 CFR §104.3 (b)(1)) For future filings, please refer to the Campaign Guide.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
