This letter is a follow-up to a letter filed on April 14, 2003 in response to the FEC's Request for Additional Information dated December 11, 2002 ("RFAI") and the 2d Request for Additional Information dated January 30, 2003 ("2d RFAI") regarding ACLI PAC's 12-Day Pre-General Report (10/1/02-10/16/02) ("2002 Pre-General Report").

We have been in the process of researching the information needed to respond to the questions posed in the RFAI, and have amended the 2002 Pre-General Report to reflect in-kind contributions from the ACLI PAC to the following federal committees:


The delay in payment by ACLI PAC resulted from a billing error by the outside vendor who mistakenly included the amounts for these events in a larger invoice to ACLI instead of separately billing ACLI PAC. At that time, ACLI PAC immediately paid ACLI for the portion of the bills properly payable by ACLI PAC and notified the campaign committees of the in kind contribution(s) as indicated by the letters.
