

This memo is in response to FEC inquiry on January 25, 2007.

Regarding the 3 48-Hour notice discrepancies:

On October 24, 2006, a \$2000 contribution was received from the American Medical Association PAC and separate \$1000 contributions were received from Darden Restaurant Employee Good Government Fund and PCI PAC. These contributions were reported to the FEC in 48 Hour reports according to the day they were received. However, due to human error, these contributions were recorded according to the bank deposit date of October 31, 2006. Therefore, in the original Post-General Report submitted on Thursday, December 7, 2006, it appeared that these contributions were not disclosed. The Post-General Report FEC-263625 has been amended and reflects these 3 contributions as being received and reported on October 24, 2006.

Regarding best efforts:

It is the practice of the campaign to request occupation and employee information in all solicitations. As well, it is disclosed on solicitations that this information is required by the FEC. Then, if necessary, the following letter will be sent to contributors that do not include their occupation and employee information.

"Thank you for your generous contribution to Congressman Connie Mack's re-election campaign.

As you may know, contributions to Federal candidates are limited under law. It is the responsibility of Congressman Mack's campaign to ensure that your contribution does not exceed the contribution limits. Any individual may give a maximum of \$2,100 to a Federal candidate's campaign committee and this limit applies separately to each election. Primaries, runoffs and general elections are considered to be separate elections. A husband and wife each have separate contribution limits, even if only one spouse has an income.

Further, it is the responsibility of our campaign to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer of individuals whose contributions exceed \$200 in an election cycle.

According to our records you have made the following contributions to Congressman Mack:

However, you did not include your occupation and name of employer along with your contribution. We are required by law to request this information from you. It is also required by law that this information be disclosed to the FEC in conjunction with our report that discloses your contribution.
