On July 15, 1998 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


The Commission is in receipt of your letter dated July 29, 1998. Please be advised that if the information requested by the Commission is not received within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.

-The Commission is in receipt of your amendment concerning your 1998 June Monthly Report. However, by FEC calculations you have a total of six contributions to the Paul Coverdell campaigns including Breakfast Club Explorers, Coverdell Good Government Committee and Coverdell Capitol Trust, totaling \$6,500. Your amendment states that you wish to redesignate \$500 of the \$1,000 contribution to Breakfast Club Explorers on 5/28/98 to the general election. This redesignation does not appear to put your committee at or under the contribution limit of \$5,000 per election. Please amend any reports necessary to correct this discrepancy.
