
Reference is made to your recent letter concerning contributions of the B&W Good Government Fund to the Craig for U.S. Senate Committee (identification number: C00063461 and reference: June Monthly report 5/1/96-5/31/96).

In accordance with the instructions that you provided to Mr. John H. Henry, our Manager of Legislative Affairs and our PAC Representative in Washington, I have sent the enclosed letter to the Treasurer of the Craig for U.S. Senate Committee. This letter states that the checks sent on October 27, 1993 for \$1,000, August 4, 1994 for \$1,000, April 4, 1995 for \$1,000 and August 8, 1995 for \$2,000 and totalling the sum of \$5,000 should have been designated as contributions for the Primary instead of the General Election. The last check cut on May 7, 1996 will remain as a contribution to the General Election as it was originally reported.

I regret that we failed to designate the first \$5,000 as contributions to the Primary. Thank you for bringing this matter to our attention, and I trust that this action will rectify the problem.

I have just received a letter from Mrs. Amy Suzanne Reynolds, Reports Analyst, Federal Election Commission, regarding our contributions to the Craig for U.S. Senate Committee which exceed the limits set forth in the Federal Election Act.

As the Treasurer for the Babcock & Wilcox Good Government Fund, I cut the following checks to Senator Craig's Committee:


- (1) October 27, 1993 for \$1,000
- (2) August 4, 1994 for \$1,000
- (3) April 4, 1995 for \$1,000
- (4) August 8, 1995 for \$2,000
- (5) May 7, 1996 for \$1,000

The checks written on October 27, 1993, August 4, 1994, April 4, 1995, and August 8, 1995 totaling \$5,000 should have been designated as contributions for the Primary instead of the General Election. The final check written on May 7, 1996 in the amount of \$1,000 should remain as it has been reported to the Federal Election Commission as a contribution to the General Election.

The above course of action puts us in compliance with the Federal Election statute. We are carrying out the above procedure in accordance with the instructions given by Mrs. Reynolds to Mr. John H. Henry, our Manager of Federal Legislative Affairs and our PAC Representative in Washington.
