This letter is sent in response to your request for additional information dated April 22 , 2013.

The original disclosures contained on Schedule D, Line 10 - Debts and Obligations Owed by the Committee were based on good faith estimates of uninvoiced charges owed to the vendor as required under 11 CFR 104.11(b). The increase arose from an examination of invoices that were created by the vendor and received by the Committee after the filing date of the October Quarterly Report. These invoices were dated in October, 2012 and referenced work performed in September, 2012. Under the Committee's contract with the vendor, the charge for this work was calculated and paid when the invoices were created. In accordance with accrual basis accounting, the Committee included these charges on the amended October Quarterly Report.
