Thank you for your letter dated June 29, 1995, which raised concerns about two issues, both of which are addressed below:

1. You correctly noted a Schedule B report listing a contribution to a candidate in excess of \$1000. However, the check for \$2000 was never delivered to the candidate and was later voided (see attached copy of voided check). Those funds were reported as returned in a later filed March 1995 monthly report, Schedule B (copy enclosed).
2. Our computer-generated reports were initially submitted for approval by letter dated September 12, 1994. A Mr. John D. Gibson approved our filing in his letter dated October 5, 1994 (copy enclosed).
