All solicitations of contributions to the Committee's federal account include clear and conspicuous requests for contributor information and inform the potential contributor that federal law requires the committee to report such information. If a contributor does not provide such information (whether or not the contribution was solicited), the Committee's staff initiates a written request in the form of a letter with an enclosed pre-addressed, postage-paid return envelope for the required information upon learning of receipt of a contribution of \$200 or more, or upon learning that a contributor's aggregate contributions during the calendar year exceed \$200. Such written requests clearly ask for the missing information and inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information, and do not include a solicitation for further contributions. Any updated information is included in the Committee's next filing with the FEC.

The unitemized contributions on line 11(a)(ii) of the Committee's October 20, 2015 monthly report are from contributors whose aggregate contributions for the year totaled less than \$200 as of the close of the reporting period.

The employee salaries disclosed on Schedule H4 supporting Line 21(a) of the report are for employees who spent 25% or less of their time on FEA or activities in connection with a Federal election during the reporting period. No employees of the committee spent more than 25% of their time on FEA or activities in connection with a Federal election.
