This letter will serve to correct recent mistakes concerning contributions made on 11/25/08 from the College of American Pathologists Political Action Committee (FEC ID# C00274944).

In your letter dated from March 27<sup>th</sup>, it is stated that the College of American Pathologists Political Action Committee "discloses one or more contributions to a candidate (s) for the 2008 general election; however, the funds were disbursed after the election date." Please note that these 5 contributions were originally intended to serve as 2008 general election debt retirement contributions:

According to www.fec.gov, the Committee to Elect Alan Grayson, Peters for Congress and Pingree for Congress still have campaign debt from the 2008 general election. Therefore, the College of American Pathologists Political Action Committee will amend its Year End FEC Report to correctly disclose that the purpose of the \$2,500 contributions made to each of these campaign committees on 11/25/08 is for 2008 general election debt relief.

By the time the Kosmas for Congress and Martin Heinrich for Congress campaign committees received the \$2,500 contributions from the College of American Pathologists Political Action Committee, neither candidate had any debt remaining from the 2008 general election. Therefore, I requested a full refund from Kosmas for Congress. I have also requested that the \$2,500 contribution made to Martin Heinrich for Congress be redesignated as a 2010 primary contribution. I have included copies of all relevant communication with these two candidate campaign committees.
