Dear Mr. Rodgers:

On June 4, 1997, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your June 20, 1997 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The Commission acknowledges your response concerning your excessive contribution to the Illinois Right to Life PAC and the National Right to Life PAC. You state, "These committees are not affiliated, therefore they do not share the same aggregate." Please be advised that the Illinois Federation for Right to Life, Inc. PAC filed an amended Statement of Organization with the Commission on April 16, 1996 which disclosed the National Right to Life PAC as an affiliated committee. This committee has not amended its Statement of Organization since that time.

Additionally, your response referenced MUR 996 which involved the National Right to Life and many of the state Right to Life committees. On July 14, 1981, the Commission voted to take no action at that time with regard to the possible affiliation of the Right to Life political committees and closed the file on MUR 996. The Commission did not make a final determination concerning the possible affiliation.


For the aforementioned reasons, Schedule B of your report (pertinent portions attached) discloses contributions which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. 2 U.S.C. §441a(a) precludes a committee from making contributions to another political committee and its affiliates in excess of \$5,000 per calendar year. You should notify the recipient committees and request a refund of the amount in excess of \$5,000.

Please immediately inform the Commission of your corrective action in writing and provide a photocopy of the refund request to the recipient committees and a photocopy of the refund check.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
