Dear Ms. Perry,

We are in receipt of your letter dated July 11, 2002, which presented specific questions regarding Pfizer's FEC report. This letter is intended to respond and further clarify these questions.

With regard to the two contributions by Pfizer's PAC to Issa for Congress and Texans for Henry Bonilla, we have amended our reports accordingly. Our report will reflect a redesignation to the general election for the contribution to the Bonilla campaign (FEC August Monthly Report) and we placed a stop payment on the check to the Issa for Congress campaign and re-issued a check to his general election (FEC July Monthly Report).

You also inquired about a \$1,000 transfer from Pfizer's affiliated State PAC to its Federal PAC. The \$1,000 presumed to be a "transfer" from the non-federal account was actually the disclosure of a refund from a contribution made earlier in the year from the Federal PAC to Pfizer's State PAC. On December 4, 2001, the Federal PAC transferred funds to its State PAC. On March 29, 2002, the State PAC refunded \$1,000 to the Federal PAC. These funds were raised pursuant to federal law, originated from the Federal PAC, and may be traced back to the Federal PAC's transfer to Pfizer's affiliated State PAC on December 4, 2001.
