This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. 1. Your amended report discloses a decrease in disbursements totaling \$24,197.07 from the amounts disclosed on your original report. Please amend your report or provide an explanation to clarify why this additional activity was not provided with your amended report. (11 CFR § 104.3)

- For your information and consideration for future filings, Schedule B supporting Line 23 of your report discloses a contribution(s) to JOAN PERRY FOR CONGRESS designated for O2018, PRIMARY RUNOFF. However, Primary Runoff elections for Federal offices are not being held in this State(s)/district(s) during 2018. Contributions not designated for a valid election will be attributed to the next election for Federal office in which the candidate is participating. (11 CFR §§ 110.1(b)(2) and 110.2(b)(2)) For future filings, please include valid election designation(s) if applicable.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.
