Dear Ms. Jones,

Thank you for your letter dated February 23, 2005 regarding Campaign for Working Families' 30 Day Post General Report. We respond to your inquiry below.

You requested we clarify a receipt disclosed on Schedule A, Line 17 from Americans United to Preserve Marriage. This receipt was for a list rental. We researched list rental costs and determined a cost per name and charged an average rate for a comparable list. We charged a usual and normal rate for this service.

Secondly, you requested that we clarify all expenditures made for 'Direct Fundraising Mail Consulting,' 'Direct Fundraising Mail Production,' 'Postage' and 'Postage Direct Fundraising Mail Prod' as disclosed on Schedule B. We have reviewed these expenditures and they reflect expenditures made in connection with direct mailings to solicit funds for Campaign for Working Families. Report has been amended to clarify descriptions.

Finally, with regard to your notation that we may have failed to timely file one or more of the required 24 hour notices regarding 'last minute expenditures,' we filed our 24 hour notice before 11:59 PM Eastern Standard/Daylight Time on the day following the date on which the communication was publicly distributed or otherwise publicly disseminated. The communication that corresponds with the specifically referenced disbursement to Newspaper Connection, dated 10/21/04 for \$10,359.00 was publicly distributed or otherwise publicly disseminated on Sunday, October 24, 2004. Therefore we feel we have filed the 24-hour report in a timely manner. We have amended the report to correctly reflect the disbursement date as the dissemination date, 10/24/04.
