Dear Mr. Vuong:

This is in response to your letter dated May 14, 2013 concerning the 30 Day Post-General Report (10/18/2012-11/26/2012) of American Bridge 21st Century (the ""Committee"").

In item 1 you ask about 24 hour reports. As soon as the committee learned of the missing items covering the 10/29 24 hour report, it amended its report accordingly on 11/02. The Committee will file an additional amendment to correct the remaining missing disbursement. The Committee has reviewed its procedures for disclosing independent expenditures to ensure that all applicable expenses are captured and filed timely.

In items 2 & 3 you ask about the itemization of reimbursements to staff. On January 31, 2013, the Commission announced it was ""considering the topic of how political committees should report the ultimate payees of committee disbursements"" and released a draft interpretive rule for public comment. See Memorandum from Chair Ellen L. Weintraub and Vice Chairman Donald F. McGahn (January 31, 2013), available at http://www.fec.gov/law/ultimate_payee.pdf. The public comment period ended March 4, 2013. The Committee is monitoring the Commission's consideration of this draft rule - including whether the Commission applies the final rule on a prospective or retrospective basis - and will abide by whatever guidelines the Commission ultimately issues.
