Please file an amendment to your report to disclose the current status of these omitted debts: "American Target Advertising," "Data Management Inc.," "Day & Night Printing," and "RHA Marketing LLC." (11 CFR §§ 104.3(d) and 104.11)
3. Schedule D of your report itemizes debts owed to "American Target Advertising," "Capital Enterprise Associates LLC," "Morgan Meredith & Associates," and "RHA Marketing LLC" with outstanding beginning balances not included on your previous report. Please file an amendment to your report(s) to correct this discrepancy. (11 CFR § 104.11(b))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
