Re: R.J. Reynolds PAC (C00042002)

Two issues related to campaign contributions to Alexander for Senate 2008, Inc.:

First, the August 9 letter you received regarding exceeded campaign contribution limits to Alexander for Senate 2008, Inc. incorrectly reported a \$1,000 contribution having been made on June 24. The contribution was in fact made on July 24, 2007. The Alexander campaign will redesignate this contribution to the general election, and we have reported it as a general election contribution on our August monthly report.

Secondly, because the May 17 and May 31, 2007 contributions to the Alexander campaign exceeded the 60-day limit for amendments, the campaign was unable to redesignate these two contributions. Alexander for Senate 2008, Inc. has refunded both contributions, in the aggregated amount of \$3,500, which will be reported as a refund on our September report.

It has come to our attention that the R.J. Reynolds PAC (C00042002) has exceeded the campaign contribution limits to the Alexander for Senate 2008 primary campaign. This is a result of contributions totaling \$5,000 made to the campaign in 2004 and 2005 by Conwood Holdings Inc. PAC (C00317883), an affiliated PAC as of June 12, 2006. By combining our contributions, we have obviously gone over the 2008 primary limit.

Would you please redesignate the following contribution from the R.J. Reynolds PAC to your 2008 general campaign, rather than the primary:
