This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. 1. The beginning cash balance of this report does not equal the ending balance of your Year-End Report (7/1/17 - 12/31/17). Please correct this discrepancy and amend all subsequent report(s) that may be affected by the correction. (52 U.S.C. §30104(b) (formerly 2 U.S.C. § 434(b)(1)))

2. Line 7, Column A of the Summary Page does not equal Line 31, Column A of the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy. (11 CFR § 104.3(c))

- It has come to the attention of the Federal Election Commission that the reports you have filed during the current election cycle do not reflect the appropriate coverage dates for quarterly filing status. Please be advised of the filing dates and coverage periods for the 2017-2018 election cycle and fill in the appropriate dates on Line 5 of the Summary Page. For your information and consideration when preparing future filing, refer to the schedule provided for your next filing. (52 U.S.C. \$30104(a) (formerly 2 U.S.C. \$34(a)) and 11 CFR \$104.5(c))

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due

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date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered**.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
