Dear Mr. Wiquist:

In response to your letter dated September 29, 2004, we would like to clarify the following items:

We have amended our July Quarterly Report and our August Monthly Report to correctly show the outstanding balances for debt(s) owed to Scott Lauf and Linda Muller. The amounts had inadvertently been left off an amended report for the July Quarterly period; the current amendment for that period and subsequent reports should now be shown correctly.

Regarding the identification of all individuals contributing in excess of \$200: Our original solicitation does include a clear request for the contributor information pursuant to federal law; we have instituted a procedure whereby any contribution received that does not have complete information will receive a follow-up well within the 30-day period; follow-ups on all individuals with currently missing information, primarily occupation and employer, has been requested as a stand-alone effort, with no solicitation, and including an addressed return envelope. We have received and are still receiving this information. All affected filed reports will be amended before the next regularly scheduled report (Nov. 20) showing current information at that time. If any are still missing, we will submit at that time a "best efforts" report.

Again, all past reports have been amended with our best effort at clearly showing all expenditures, especially postage, mailing, etc. We reviewed those that you felt were unclear, and found no expenditures made on behalf of any specifically identified federal candidates. We have made administrative changes in an attempt to avoid confusion or ambiguity in the future.

We believe that we have addressed or are in the process of addressing all the concerns you expressed in this letter.
