This Committee responds to the April 25, 2013 RFAI as follows: This Committee exercises its best efforts to report the complete identification of all contributors who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. First, this Committee makes a clear and conspicuous request for this information on its website donation platform and on the standardized solicitation materials distributed to prospective contributors in advance of events and in other communications from fundraising personnel to prospective contributors. Second, contributors who do not provide that information originally receive a subsequent for that information. Third, when that information is obtained after the filing of a report, reports are amended. However, no additional information has been received with respect to the subject report. This RFAI notes additional information, specifically that this committee (a Leadership PAC of a Member of Congress) made a payment to the authorized committee of that Member, and that this payment should be treated as a contribution. That is erroneous. This payment was a partial payment for travel expenses related to activity that was partly related to campaign purposes and partly related to PAC purposes; consequently it is appropriate that the expense be shared by the committees and where, as here, a payment can only be made by one payee, the other payee should reimburse its share of expenses. This is an operating expenditure and not a contribution.
