This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action. Additional information is needed for the following item:

-Schedules A and B of your reports disclose \$3,656.28 in activity for the apparent receipt and transfer-out, respectively, of misdeposited funds, which have been identified as MEMO entries. The Commission notes the additional text included in your report which reads "We mistakenly used our PAC fund deposit slips when trying to deposit money into our other business account," and "This transfer of money from our PAC account to our general account occurred after the deposits made 9/8/2009 and 9/21/2009 were discovered to be posted into the wrong bank account." Please be advised, a MEMO entry is used to disclose additional information about an itemized transaction and the amount of a MEMO entry is not included in the total receipts or disbursements for the report. If these funds were deposited into, and transferred-out of, your federal account, please amend your report to correctly disclose this activity.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee

will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
