This is a very difficult letter for me to write. I have decided that I can no longer serve as the Treasurer of Carney for Congress. Please accept my resignation as of Friday, January 13, 2012.

When I first met you at Penn State, when you were interviewing on campus, I was very impressed with your obvious ability to succeed in an academic environment. Over the years, my regard for your dedication and sense of responsibility continued to increase. Six years ago, when you decided to run for Congress, I enthusiastically volunteered to do whatever I could to help your campaign from stuffing envelopes to contributing what I could afford. I truly felt that you could eventually succeed to the highest office in the country. I was honored when you asked me to serve as the Treasurer of Carney for Congress.

However, the situation with the campaign debts from the 2010 campaign has put me in a position that I find untenable and unable to do the job you need done. The campaign owes NGP-VAN approximately \$3800. They have shut off our access to our database until the balance is paid in full. I am thus unable to file the year-end FEC reports that are due at the end of the month. I have continually been receiving dunning notices from Universal Printing, which the campaign owes \$3392, and the fact that Vince Rongione is still owed over \$6000, greatly upsets me.

Let me know to whom I should turn over all the records and files.
