In response to your letter dated December 17, 2003, we have amended the FEC REPORT OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS for the months of March and April 2003.

The FEC reporting software, by default, placed those entries as "itemized if over \$200." Our new understanding is that we must review all reports and manually set entries to "un-itemized."

Reported "itemized" entries on the March and April 2003 reports (page 3, line 11i) have been changed to "un-itemized" (page 3, line 11ii).

All political contributions disclosed by District Council 37 are entirely from our membership, fee payers and retirees.

We apologize for not responding sooner. Unfortunately, the first we saw of the letter was as a result of a phone call from Andy Dodson at the FEC. For reasons that are not clear, the letter was sent to an unknown post office box. In any case, Mr. Dodson gave us very helpful instructions and guided us through the FEC web site to find the information we needed.
