I am in receipt of your letter of January 5, 2001 regarding the Termination Report that was filed on December 4, 2000. Please be advised that AIL Systems merged with EDO Corporation (PAC ID # C000329318) on April 28, 2000, and we have therefore, also merged the AIL PAC into the EDO PAC, since the two PACS are now affiliated. All of the residual funds that were reported on the Termination Report with the exception of \$5.06, were transferred into the EDO PAC on December 18, 2000. This transfer will be reflected on the EDO PAC filing that is due on January 31, 2001.

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your Termination Report discloses \$13,677.65 in residual funds. According to 11 CFR §102.3(a), a committee must satisfy the following conditions before it can terminate: 1) it will no longer receive any contributions or make any disbursements that would otherwise qualify it as a political committee; 2) all outstanding debts and obligations have been extinguished (see 11 CFR §§116.1(a), 116.2(a) and 116.7 for debt settlement option); and 3) a statement has been submitted regarding the disposition of the committee's residual funds. Please provide any clarifying information regarding the residual funds disclosed on your Termination Report. Please be advised that reports must be filed until the conditions of 11 CFR §102.3(a) have been fully satisfied.
