Dear Mr. Ragan:

Enclosed is our response to your letter dated September 19, 2000. Your request was as follows:

Schedule A of your report discloses contributions which appear to exceed the limits set forth in the Act. Copies of some, but not all, of the apparent excessive contribution are attached for your information. You should examine all of your contributions to check for additional excessives. The Committee's procedures for processing contributions should also be reviewed.

Our response to your request is enclosed as copies of the redesignation letters with the exception of Mr. Greg Nolan. Mr. Nolan requested that \$100.00 be refunded and those funds have been returned to him. In addition, we repeatedly requested redesignations from: James R. Baker, Sr. \$1,000.00, Glynn J. Rivet, \$500.00 and Segura Farms Partnership, Donald P. Segura, \$200.00. Unfortunately, we have received no response from these three contributors. Thus, those contributions have been returned.

In examining the Committee's procedures for processing contributions, it has been suggested to me that we create a contribution card containing the language below and that the card include a signature line. The suggested language is as follows:
