Dear Mr. Weldon:

On April 10, 1996 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your April 15, 1996 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Your amended Detailed Summary Page discloses \$1,839.28 as both itemized and unitemized receipts. Contributions from individuals that aggregate greater than \$200 in a calendar year should be itemized on Schedule A and reflected only on Line 11(a)(i). All contributions received that total \$200 or less per individual should be reported on Line 11(a)(ii). Please clarify to which category your committee's individual receipts belong.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
