Dear Mr. Furman:

This statement is filed by Milton Wolf for US Senate response to your Request for Additional Information (RFAI) dated 4/8/2015 regarding the October Quarterly Report (7/17/2014 – 9/30/2014). The RFAI outline three issues: refunds of contributions designated to the General 2014 Election; contribution limits and excessive contributions; and 48 Hour Notices for the Primary 2014 .

As you know, the campaign did not receive the RFAI until today, July 13, 2015. We are evaluating the technical statues of the email address on file to ensure that we receive any future communications from the Commission. We will amend the Statement of Organization as necessary to update the email address. We apologize for the late response to you RFAI.

We are in the process of evaluating the information and data related to the issues outline in the RFAI. We plan to provide a fully detailed response as a follow up to this statement.

Based on a preliminary review of the information, we can provide some initial information regarding items 2 and 3 in the in RFAI regarding excessive contributions and the 48 Hour Notices, respectively.

Regarding the excessive contributions for James Downey and Tom Macy: Some of the contributions listed were incorrectly coded as contributions designated for Primary 2014. This error is due to a clerical error in the data entry of the contributions into the FEC Filing Software. Once a comprehensive review of the reports is completed (in connection with item 1 of the RFAI), we will be filing amended reports to correct the designations of the affected contributions as follows:

James Downey: \$250 of \$500 contribution, dated 7/27/2014, designated for General 2014;
\$600 contribution, dated 7/31/2014, designated General 2014;
Ted Macy: \$600 contribution, dated 7/18/2014, designated General 2014.

Regarding the 48 Hour Notices (Notices): All of the contributions listed in RFAI were reported on 48 Hour Notices filed with the Secretary of the Senate. The related Notices were filed on or before the dues date. However, the Secretary of the Senate did not reflect receipt of the filings. Upon discovery of the error, the committee acted to rectify the issue by re-submitting the filings

to the Secretary of the Senate. While most of the Notices were received and recorded by the Secretary of the Senate on 10/31/2014, for some unknown reasons, one of the packages sent to the Secretary of the Senate was not received and so the Notices were not recorded yet again. This final set of Notices was filed for a third time with the Secretary of the Senate and they were recorded with the date of 11/12/2014.

We are in the process of gathering the proof of filing for all of these Notices that relate to the contributions listed in the RFAI. When we file our detailed response to the RFAI, we will include all the available documentation regarding the filings.

So that you may reference the Notices that are on file, the table below provides an index to locate the Notices based on the filing date ultimately recorded by the Secretary of State.




