Dear Mr. Huckaby:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-Schedule B supporting Line 21(b) of your report discloses payments made to credit card companies. Payments made to credit card companies must identify in memo entries, the original vendors from which you have purchased an item or service if your payments to these vendors have exceeded \$200 this year. Please amend your report by providing the name and mailing address of the original vendor, along with the date, amount and purpose of each payment as required by 11 CFR §104.9(b) and clearly identify on the Schedule B, which credit card payment each memo entry relates to.

-The coordinated expenditure schedule (Schedule F) should disclose the following information: the identification of the designating committee, (if applicable), the payee's name and address, the purpose of the expenditure, the identification of the candidate supported, the office sought, state and district (if applicable), the date and amount of the payment and the aggregate general election expenditure total for each candidate supported. Please amend Schedule F by clarifying the amount of the total payment that should be attributed to each candidate. In addition, please clarify the state of the election for each candidate disclosed. Please be advised that national party committees share one coordinated expenditure limit. 2 U.S.C. §441a(d)

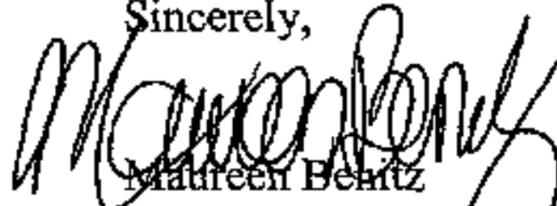
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-Schedule B supporting Line 28(a) discloses a refund of a contribution made to "CARTER, THOMAS JR," "KUNG, SOPA," "MCKENZIE, CONNIE H" and "PAVLATOS, MARINA." However, it appears that this contribution was not previously reported by your committee. Please amend the appropriate report(s) to disclose the original date of the contribution on Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
