Dear Treasurer:

The Commission has reviewed your debt settlement plan (DSP) received on 5/19/2015. Based on this review the Commission has concluded that the debt settlement plan meets the criteria set forth in 11 CFR § 116.7 and would not result in apparent violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, or the Commission Regulations.

In addition, because you indicate in Part I of your DSP that you intend to terminate, the Commission is terminating your committee in accordance with 52 U.S.C. § 30103(d) of the Federal Election Campaign Act. Your committee is no longer required to file reports on a periodic basis. However, 52 U.S.C. § 30102(d) and 11 CFR §§ 102.9(c) and 104.14(b)(3) require that you maintain your records and copies of reports for inspection for at least three (3) years. In addition, you may be required to respond to Commission requests for information regarding your committee's federal election activity and previously filed reports. If your committee again becomes active in federal elections, it will be required to re-register with the Commission in accordance with the Federal Election Campaign Act and applicable Regulations.
