Dear Ms. Carter:

We are in receipt of your letter dated September 22, 2010 regarding our July Monthly Report (6/1/10 - 6/30/10) in which you questioned the following 2 items:

1. Our May Monthly Report (4/1/10-4/30/10), June Monthly Report (5/1/10-5/31/10), and July Monthly Report (6/1/10-6/30/10) reports combined do not disclose any payments for salary or wages on schedule B.

No employee of the Wyoming Republican Party spent 25% or more of their time during the reporting periods in question on activities in connection with a Federal election. Therefore, we believe the related payments for salary and wages are reported correctly.

2. The detailed summary page for our May Monthly (4/1/10-4/30/10), June Monthly (5/1/10-5/31/10) and July Monthly (6/1/10 - 6/30/10) reports combined , disclose \$28,690 in transfers fro the Non-Federal account for allocated activity. However, line 21(a)(ii) Column A does not disclose payments for allocated activity for the reporting period.

Transfers totaling \$28,690 occurred on both April 1, 2010 and on April 6, 2010 for allocated expenditures that occurred in both February and March 2010. The transfers were made within the 70 day time period: no more than 10 days before or 60 days after the payment to the vendor. Therefore, we believe the transactions are reported correctly.
