2. Schedule H4 of our report discloses a payment(s) for vote-by-mail postage returns, and voter drive consulting services which is categorized as Voter Drive activity. These payment(s) are not made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, does not refer to a clearly identified candidate for Federal office, does not promote, support, attack, or oppose any such candidate for Federal office.
