

The purpose of this Form 99 is to respond to the RFAI from the FEC dated May 7, 2008. The RFAI requests information on two separate transactions: (1) an apparent contribution after the date of the primary election to Dutch Ruppersberger for Congress on 2/28/2008 in the amount of \$5000 for the 'primary' election, and (2) an apparent excessive contribution triggered by a contribution to Simpson for Congress on 2/28/2008 in the amount of \$5000 for the primary election. The first transaction was inadvertently listed on the March monthly report to the FEC as a 'primary' contribution. This was a clerical error and was intended to be reported a contribution to the 'general' election. An amendment will be filed to correct the clerical oversight. The second transaction appears to be an excessive contribution to the candidate because the PAC's affiliated PAC, the Society of Interventional Pain Management Surgery Centers PAC (SIPMSC PAC), made a contribution to the campaign on 3/12/2007 in the amount of \$1000 for the 'primary' election, thus potentially exceeding the allowed limit for the election by \$1000. However, it is apparent that the contribution dated 3/12/2007 from SIPMSC PAC was never received by the Simpson campaign committee. Indeed, it appears that the 3/12/2007 contribution may never actually have been made and may have been inaccurately reported by the SIPMSC PAC. As soon as confirmation of the facts are received, another Form 99 will be filed to clarify the point along with any potential amendments.
