

This Form 99 submission is in response to the Commission's letter dated March 23, 2011 regarding the Committee's Amended October Monthly Report.

- 1.The Committee received additional 441a(d) authority, which was ceded to the Committee from the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee, prior to the time the coordinated party expenditures in excess of the original limit were made.
- 2.Schedule A Supporting Line 15 discloses "Offsets To Operating Expenditures" for payments for rent. The Committee paid rent for a field office that was shared with the Clark County Democratic Committee. The Clark County Democrats paid for a proportional share of the rent expenses associated with the office, based on the proportional share of space they occupied.
- 3.The Committee has included additional information received for occupation and employer with this Form 99 response. However, in many instances the information provided by the donor is reported on our reports exactly as we have received them. This is particularly true for information provided through the Committee's website. "Challenged Child and Friends Inc." is an organization that provides high quality educational, therapeutic, nursing, and family support services to children with disabilities in and integrated environment " as explained on their website. The donor chose not to disclose their occupation. The Committee continues to maintain "best efforts" in obtaining occupation and employer information. All original solicitations contain a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor information, along with the federal requirements for reporting of such information. If the information is not provided, the committee makes a follow-up request in an effort to obtain the information.
