

Response to letter questioning July Monthly Report (6/1/08-6/30/08)

The aggregate year-to-date totals on Schedule A show the total contributions from individuals that were received by the PAC in that year. Earmarked donations for campaigns (NORPAC acting as a conduit) entered as memos are not included in the aggregate totals. Therefore the aggregate year-to-date total may appear incorrect (as it is often less than the total earmark) but it is actually recorded and calculated correctly. The NORPAC Annual Mission to Washington DC trip consists of citizen activists meeting with hundreds of members of Congress to discuss legislation. No mission expenditures on Schedule B are on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates and therefore no additional information needs to be disclosed on Schedule B or E. Any public communications such as ads are designed to recruit members to the mission and do not express advocacy or voter driver activity for any Federal candidates. Therefore no additional information needs to be disclosed on Schedule B or E.
