Dear Mr. Roberts:

On April 3, 2002, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your April 15, 2002 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-2 U.S.C. §434(b)(6)(B)(iii) requires that the supporting schedule for disclosing independent expenditures be signed by the treasurer and certified by a notary public. This is to attest to the fact that the expenditures were not made in cooperation, consultation, or concert with, or at the request or suggestion of any candidate, or any authorized committee or agent of such committee. Furthermore, please note that committees filing reports electronically must submit an electronic Schedule E, and also mail in a signed notarized paper copy of Schedule E. The Commission is in receipt of your electronic text letter stating that the paper copy of Schedule E, complete with signature and notarization, has been mailed to the Commission. Due to recent events, the United States Postal Service is experiencing delays in the delivery of mail for the Washington D.C. area. Consequently, the Federal Election Commission is not in receipt of all incoming mail and has not received of the paper copy of Schedule E.

The Commission recommends that you resubmit your paper copy of Schedule E and consider using alternate delivery services such as overnight delivery or delivery by courier. If feasible, your response can also be hand-


delivered. You can verify the Commission's receipt of any documents submitted by your committee on the FEC website at [www.FEC.gov](http://www.FEC.gov).

-The information provided on the independent expenditure schedule (Schedule E) is still incomplete. Please amend Schedule E by providing the name and office sought, state and congressional district (if applicable) of the federal candidate(s). 11 CFR §104.3(b)(3)(vii)

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by May 15, 2002. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
