This letter is being submitted in response to the Request for Additional Information ("RFAI") dated October 5, 2016. The RFAI identified 2 items you'd like for us to address:

**Item #1 – Schedule B**


The contribution and the subsequent refund were both disclosed on the original filing. The contribution can be seen on page 20 (item C) and the refund can be seen on page 150 (item A). I believe the issue leading to the RFAI may be that the contribution and the refund were each designated to different elections; the contribution was designated to the Special Primary while the refund was designated to the General. We have filed an amended report (FEC-1107608) where the refund transaction is now designated to the Special Primary (to match the contribution).

**Item #2 – Schedule A – Missing 48-Hour Notices**

This item identifies six potential contributions that should have been included on 48-hour notices and recommends that we review our procedures and amend any incomplete 48-hour notices. I've researched each of the six and have provided explanations below:

- The following 2 contributions were memo contributions included on our report; both in the amount of \$1,000 and included in a deposit of \$1,805.66 received from Americans for BBQ. The contributions were sent to Hudson For Congress on 6/22, received on 6/28 and deposited on 6/29. The contributions were not included on a 48-hour notice because they were received by Hudson For Congress after the 48-hour reporting period.
  - Express Scripts Inc Political Fund – The date included on our report (5/23/2016) was the date the funds were received by Americans for BBQ.
  - National Business Aviation Association Inc Political Action Committee – The date included on our report (6/2/2016) was the date the funds were received by Americans for BBQ.
- The following 4 contributions were mistakenly omitted from 48-hour notices filed on either 5/25/2016 (FEC-1074681) or 5/27/2016 (FEC-1075149). Each of these 48-hour notices were amended on 9/19/2016. Thank you for identifying these errors.

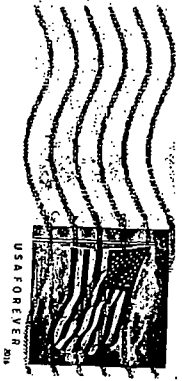


