This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 3 items:

1. Schedule A supporting Line 11(c) of your report discloses a contribution from Blue Pac. However, based on the name and address of this committee, it appears that this committee has been terminated and is no longer registered with the Commission. Please amend your report to provide further clarifying information regarding this transaction.
2. Please clarify all expenditures made for "Reimbursement - Catering & Lodging," "Catering & Lodging" and "Fundraising Consulting Services" on Schedule B. If a portion or all of these expenditures were made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates, this amount should be disclosed on Schedules B or E supporting Lines 23 or 24 and include the amount, name, address and office sought by each candidate. 11 CFR §§104.3(b) and 106.1
3. Your 30 Day Post Special Report (1/1/08-3/31/08), 30 Day Post Special Report (4/1/08-5/23/08) and July Quarterly Report (5/24/08-6/30/08) discloses limited payments for administrative expenses. Administrative expenses are payments made for the purpose of operating a political committee including, but not limited to, rent, utilities, salaries, telephone service, office equipment and supplies. Any such payments to a person aggregating in excess of \$200 in a calendar year must be disclosed on

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
