Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 1 item(s):

- Your amended report discloses an increase in receipts totaling \$11,294 from the amounts disclosed on your original report. The Commission notes the memo text attached to your report stating, in part:

"As part of an annual financial review of League of Conservation Voters Action Fund's 2013 activity we identified a vendor error that resulted in the deposit of receipts into incorrect bank accounts. This vendor error began in September and continued through December of 2013. The vast majority of these receipts fall under the \$200 aggregate yearly itemization threshold.

To correct this we will be amending the following 2013 reports on which the errors occurred:

2013 October Monthly, 2013 November Monthly, 2013 December Monthly  
2013 Year End"

Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this matter, your clarification and any additional clarification you may have will be taken into consideration. 11 CFR §104.3



**matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
